RESOLUTION V

The Circle of Presidents of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts, convened in Bucharest on 23 and 25 May 2011 on the occasion of the XVth Congress of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts,

Having regard to Article 11 paragraph 2 (a) of the Statute of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts and to Article 15 paragraph 2 of the Conference Regulations, concerning financial statement on the general costs,

Having considered the preliminary budget submitted by the Constitutional Court of Romania,

Having heard the Secretary General of the Constitutional Court of Romania,

Has unanimously decided:

- 1° To approve of the preliminary budget of the XVth Congress, as provided by the Constitutional Court of Romania.
- 2° To approve that the proceedings of the Congress shall be published in book form: the general report shall be published in French and in English; the national reports shall be published in French or in English, depending on which language they were drawn up in; five copies shall be printed for each member of the Conference; the costs of publication shall be included in the general costs of the XVth Congress.
- 3° To approve that the general costs (as specified under item A of the financial statement) be equally divided among full members of the Conference, in proportion to the number of their delegates having participated in the Congress.
- 4° To take account of the fact that all other expenses (other than the costs of interpretation in Italian and Spanish which will be borne by the respective courts) shall be covered by the Constitutional Court of Romania, as hospitality.
